

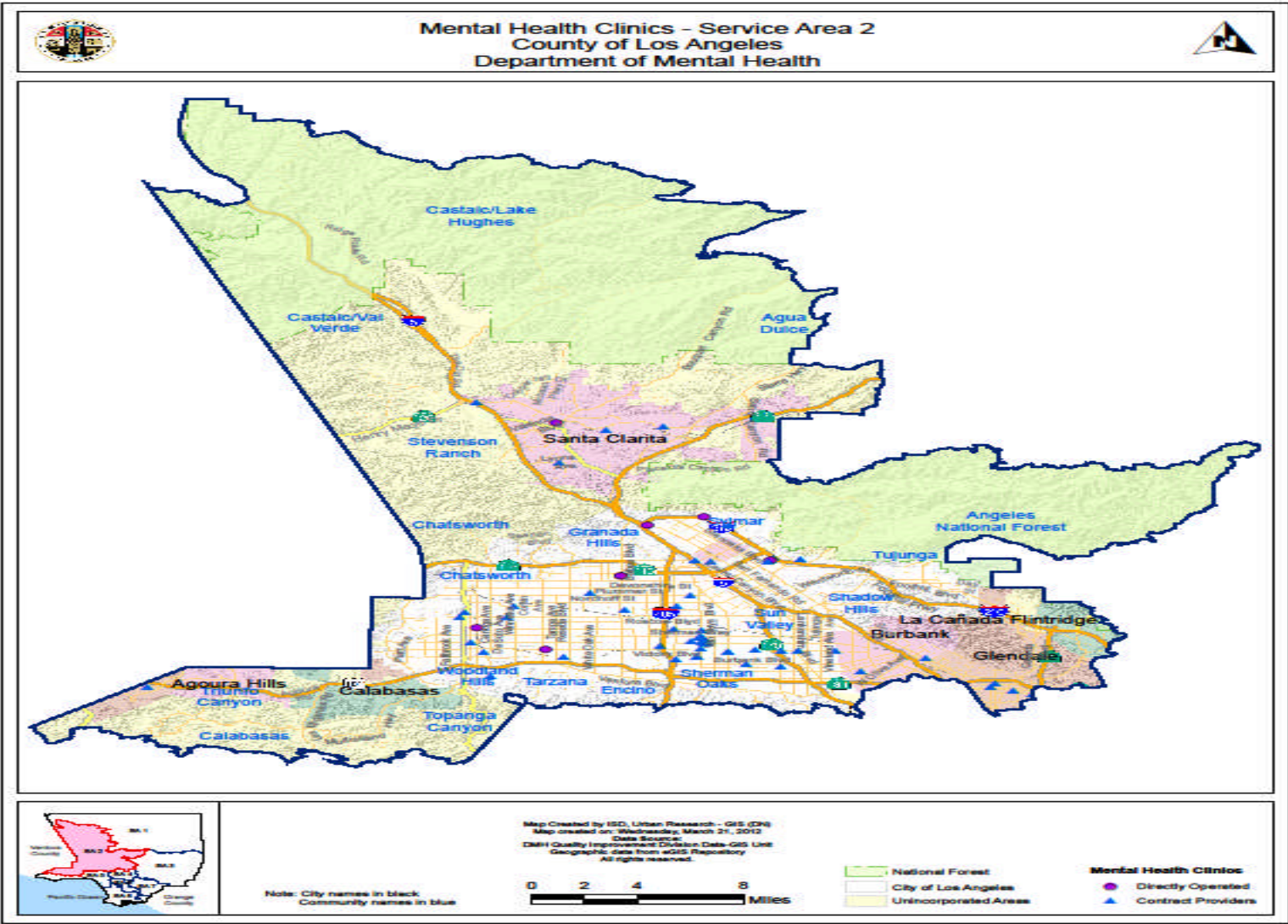

# Map of Service Area 2

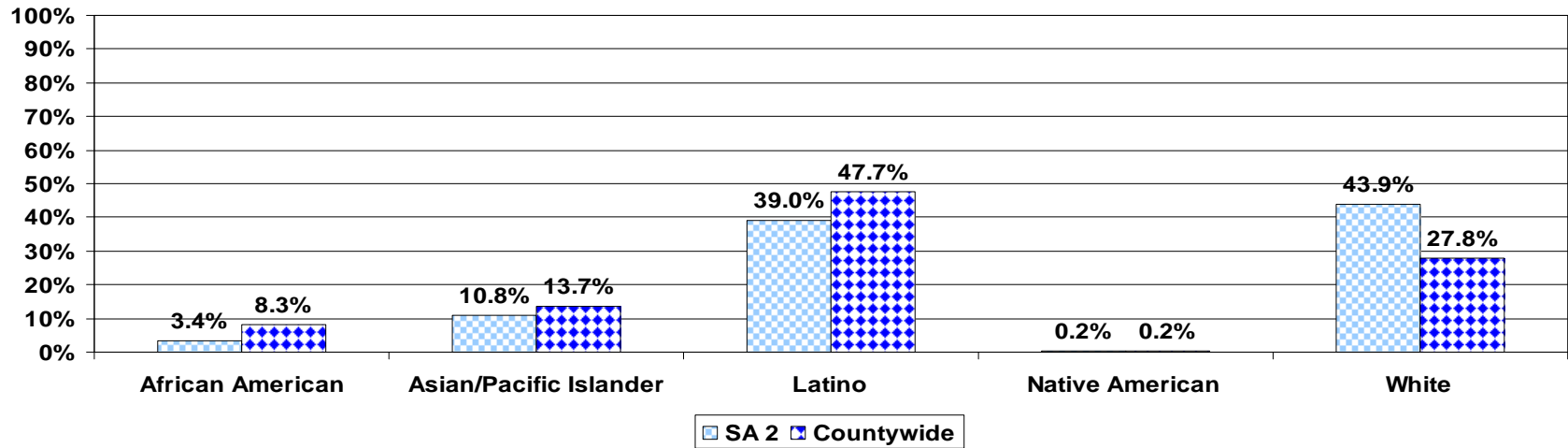


# Cities and Population Density

## SA 2 - CY 2010

- SA 2 consists of 11 legal cities or 12.5% of all cities in Los Angeles County (LAC) and has a total population of 2,124,159.
- SA 2 covers about 1,000 square miles and is approximately 25% of the land area of LAC.
- Population density in SA 2 measuring number of persons per square mile is 2,124 ( $2,124,159/1,000$ ) as compared with 2,418 in LAC.
  - Population density in California measuring number of people per square mile is 239.
  - Population density in the U.S. measuring number of people per square mile is 87.
  - SA 2 is the 7<sup>th</sup> most densely populated SA in LAC.

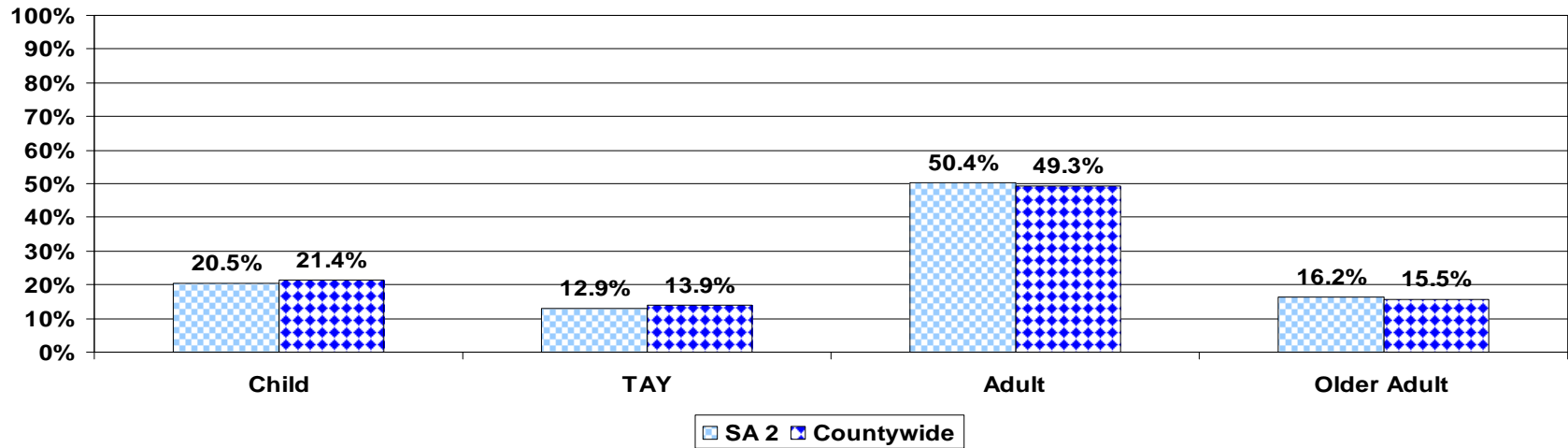
Figure 1: Population by Ethnicity

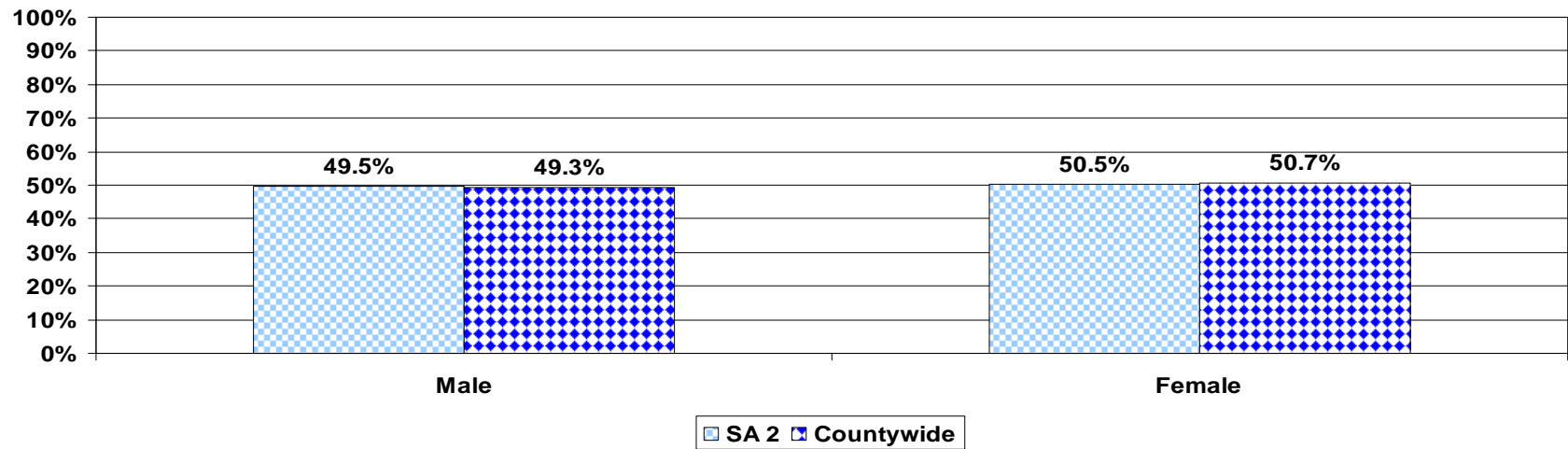
Figure 2: Population by Age Group

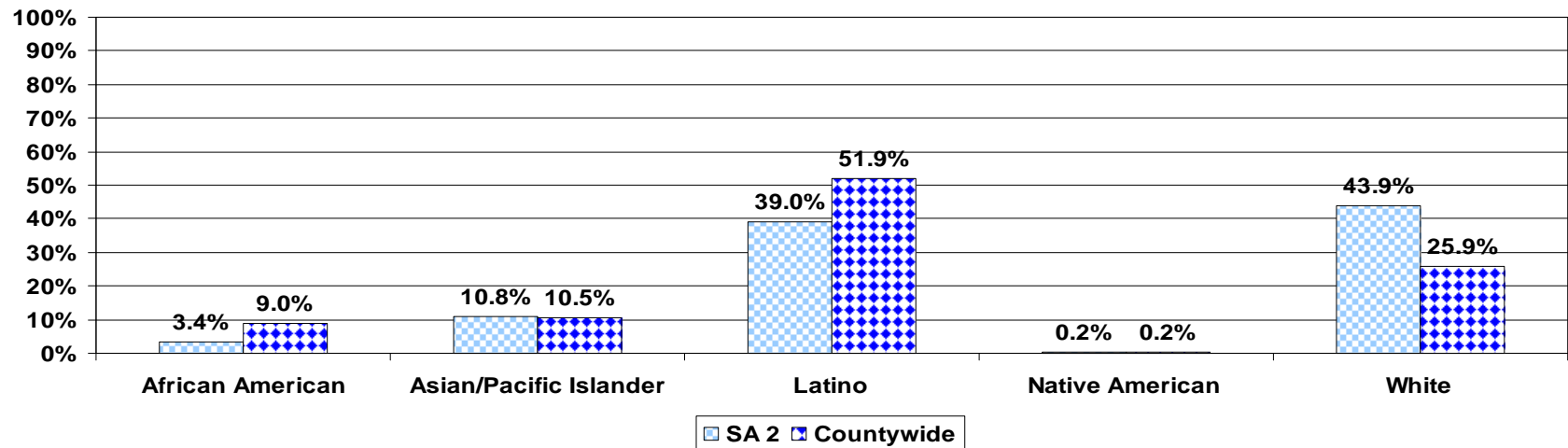
Figure 3: Population by Gender

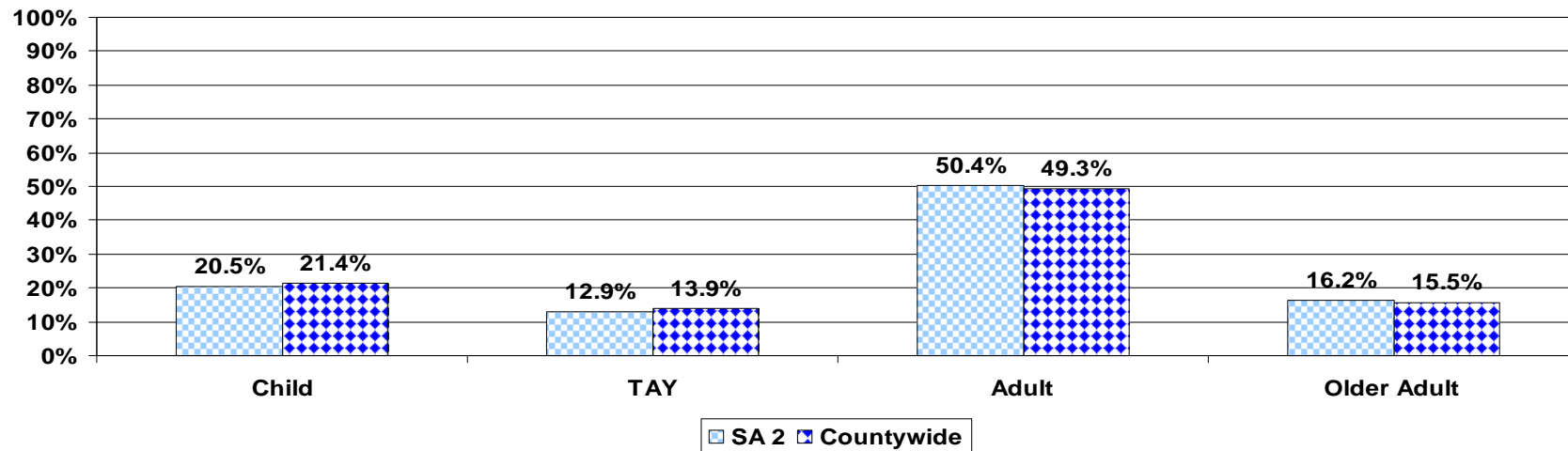
Figure 4: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI<sup>1</sup> by Ethnicity

CY 2010**

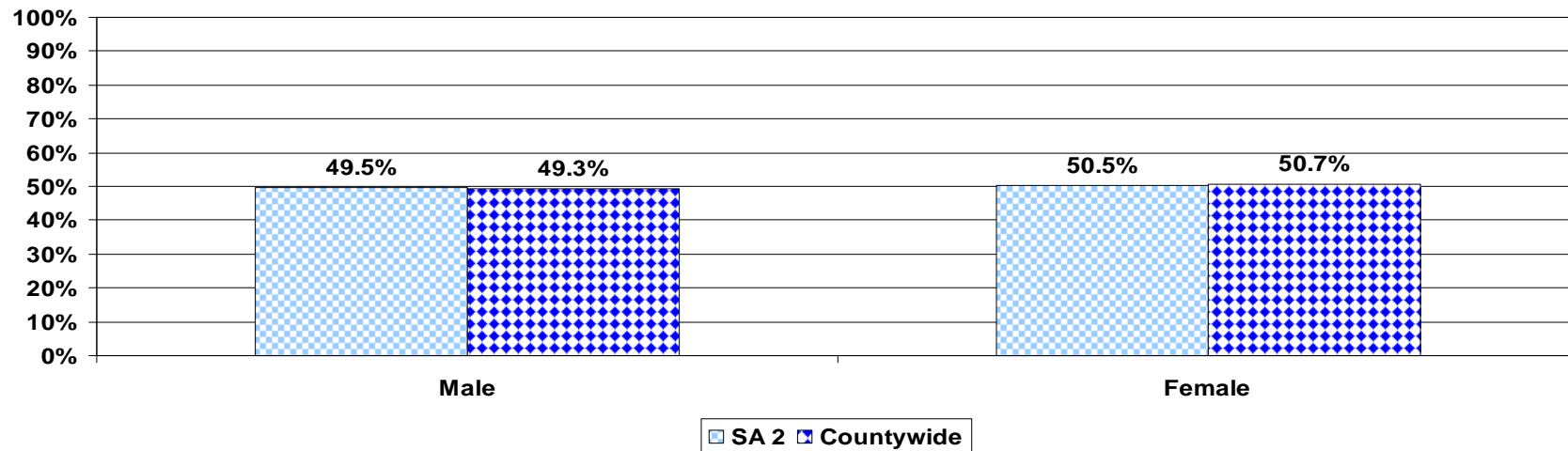

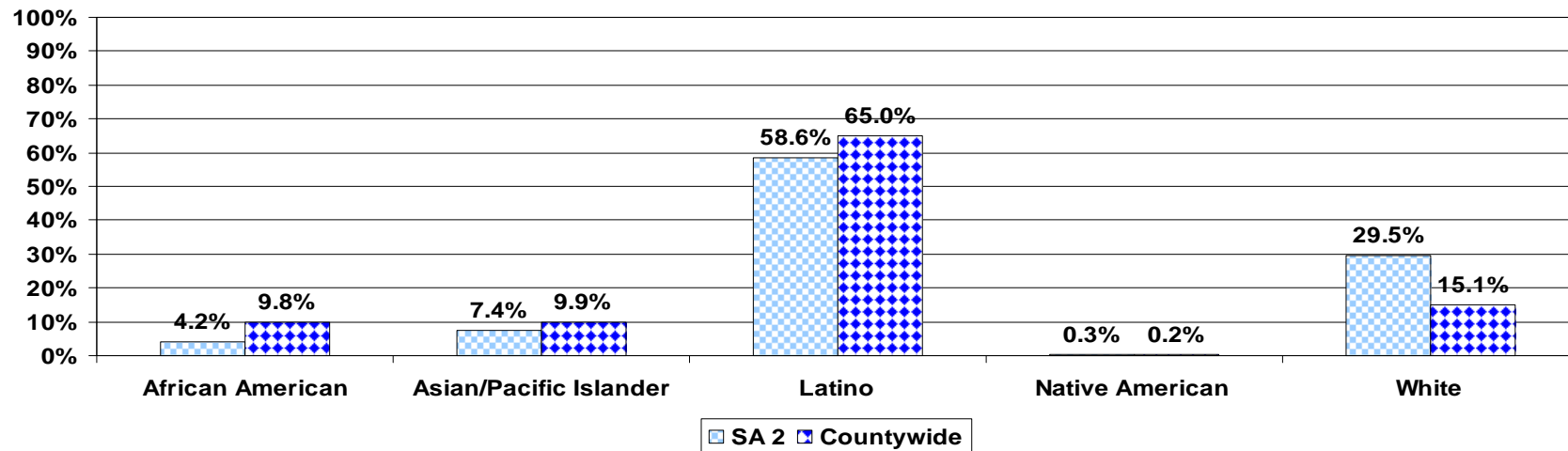
Figure 6: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI<sup>1</sup> by Gender in SA 2 Compared with Countywide CY 2010

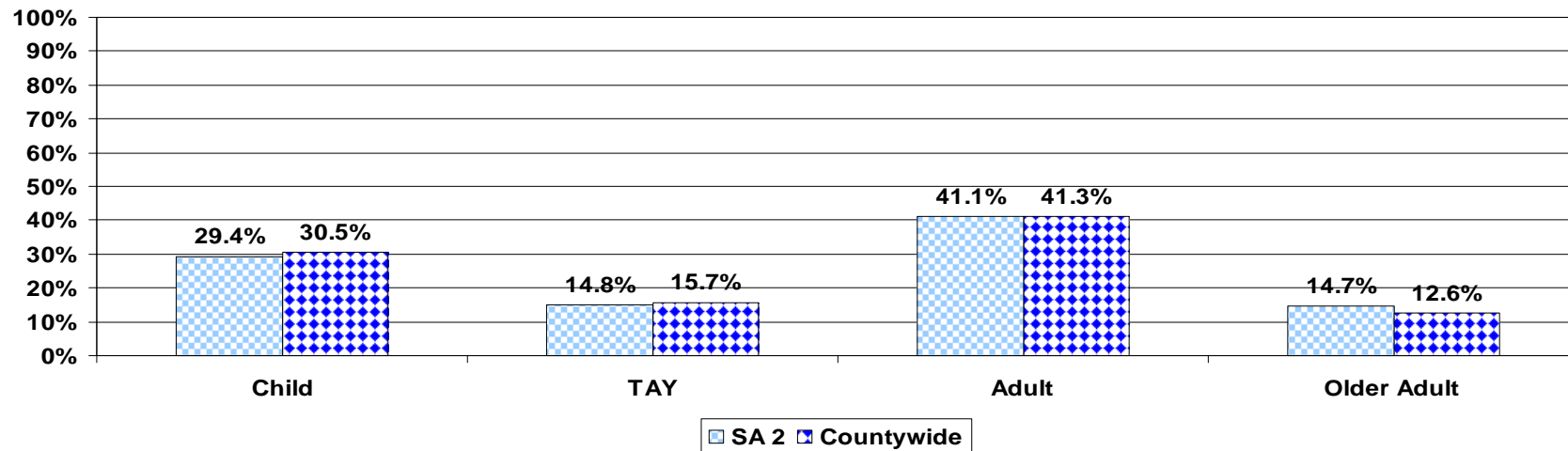
Figure 7: Estimated Population Living At or Below 200% Federal Poverty Level by Ethnicity in SA 2 Compared with Countywide CY 2010

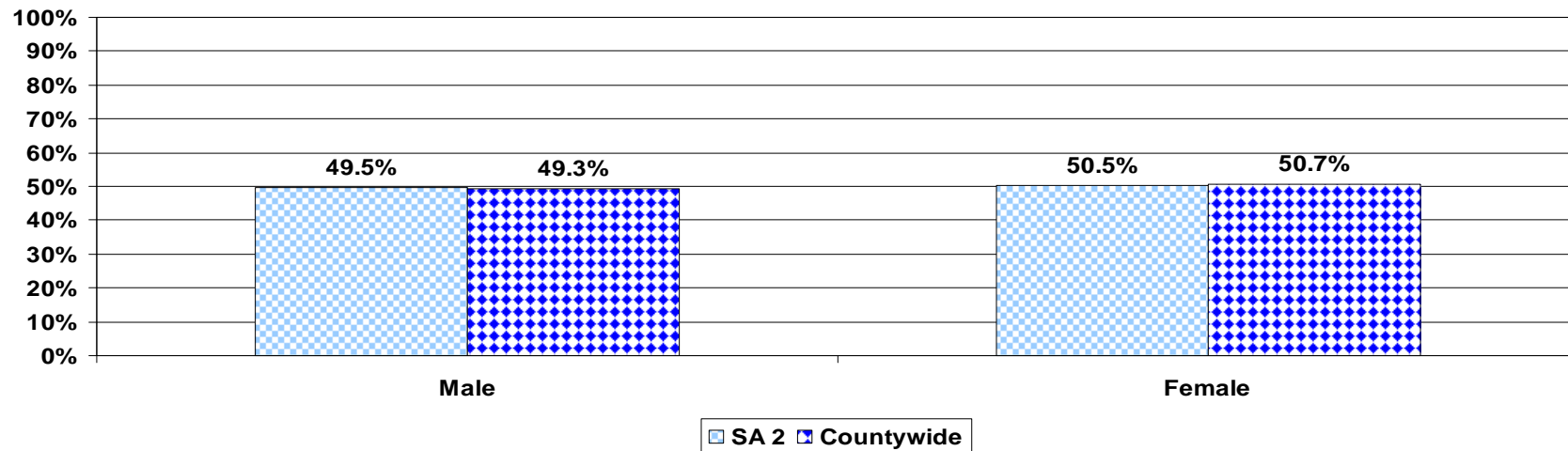
Figure 8: Estimated Population Living At or Below 200% Federal Poverty Level by Age Group in SA 2 Compared with Countywide CY 2010

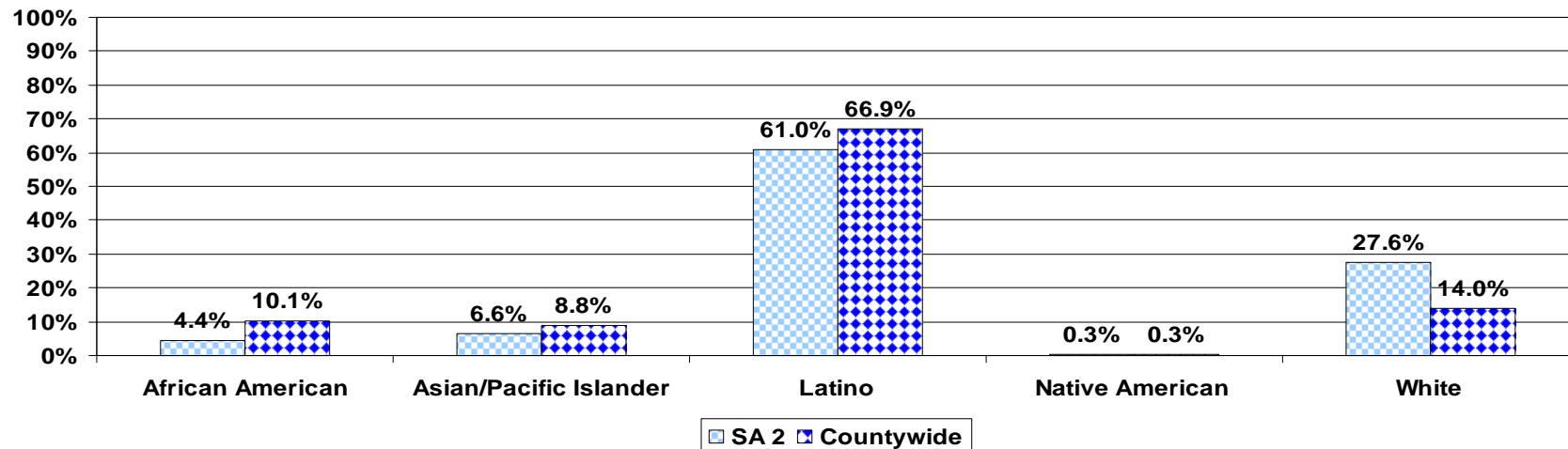
Figure 9: Estimated Population Living At or Below 200% Federal Poverty Level by Gender in SA 2 Compared with Countywide

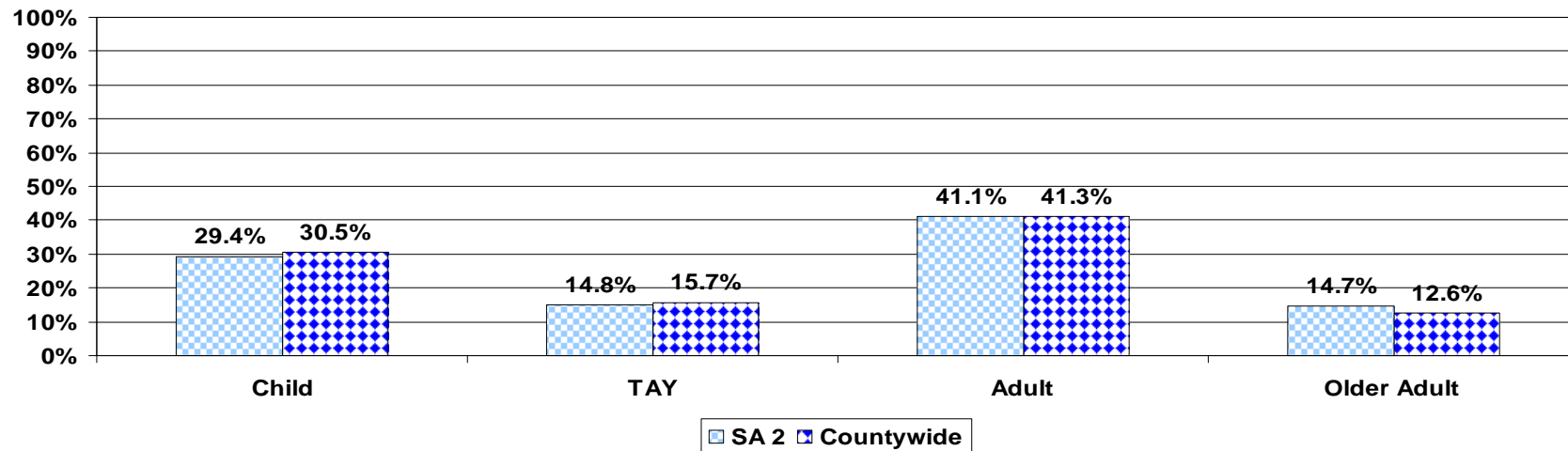
Figure 10: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI by Ethnicity Among Population Living At or Below 200% Federal Poverty Level in SA 2 Compared with Countywide CY 2010

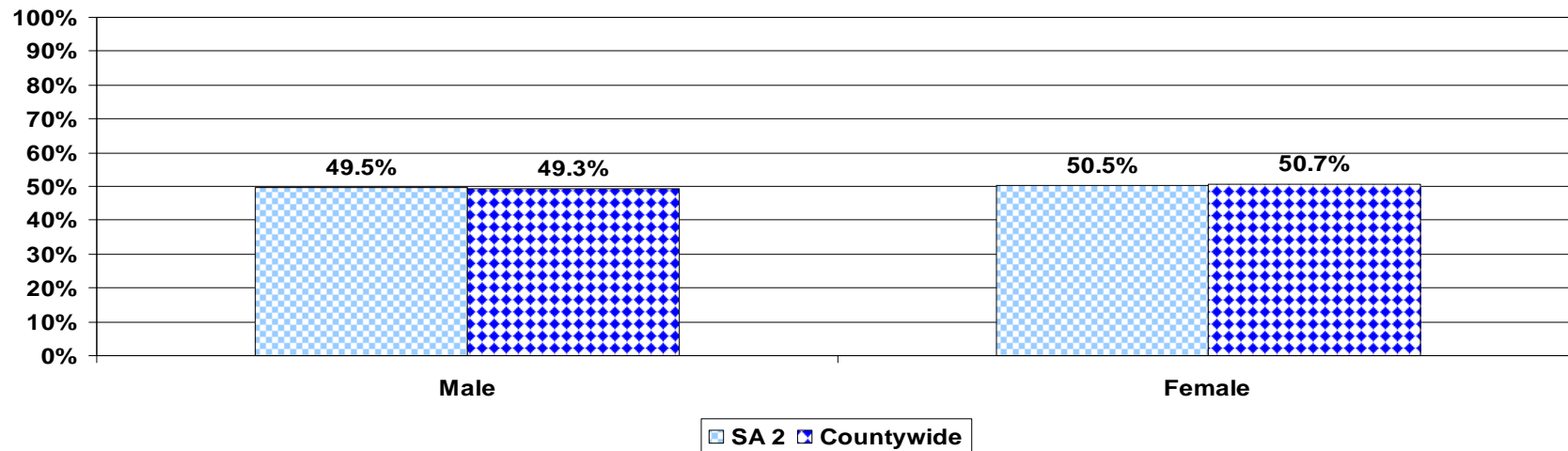
Figure 11: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI by Age Group Among Population Living At or Below 200% Federal Poverty Level in SA 2 Compared with Countywide CY 2010

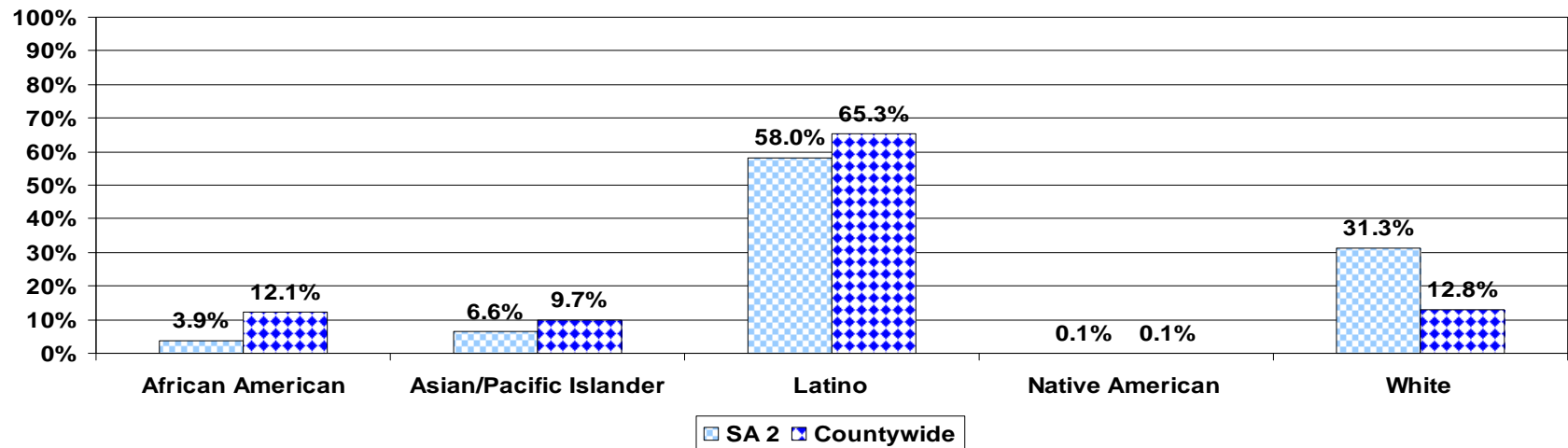
Figure 12: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI by Gender Among Population Living At or Below 200% Federal Poverty Level in SA 2 Compared with Countywide CY 2010

## Figure 13: Medi-Cal Enrolled Population by Ethnicity in SA 2 Compared with Countywide March 2011

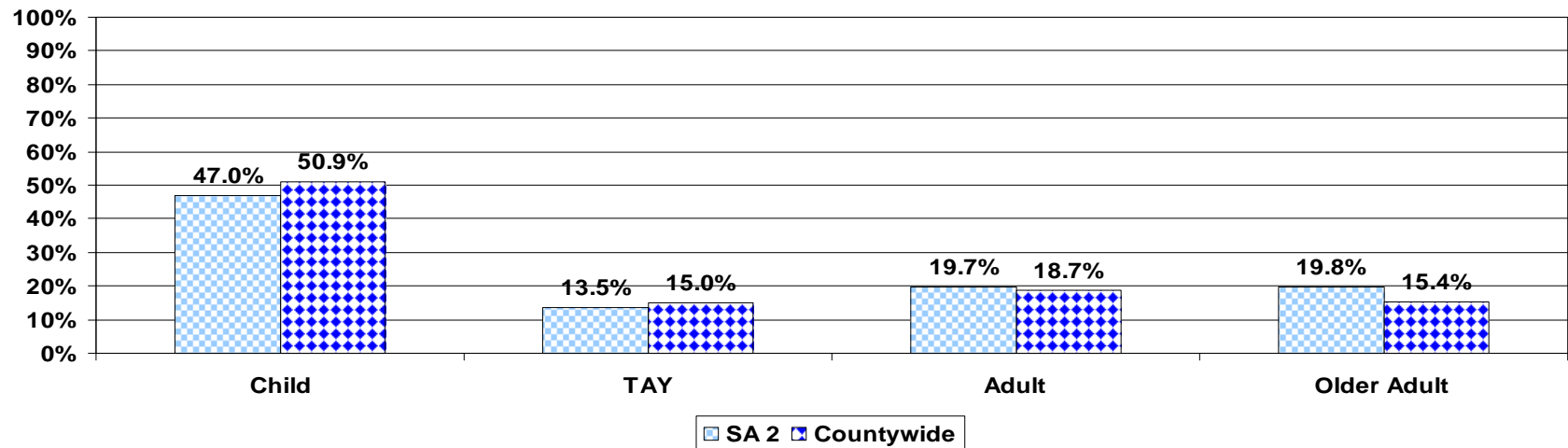

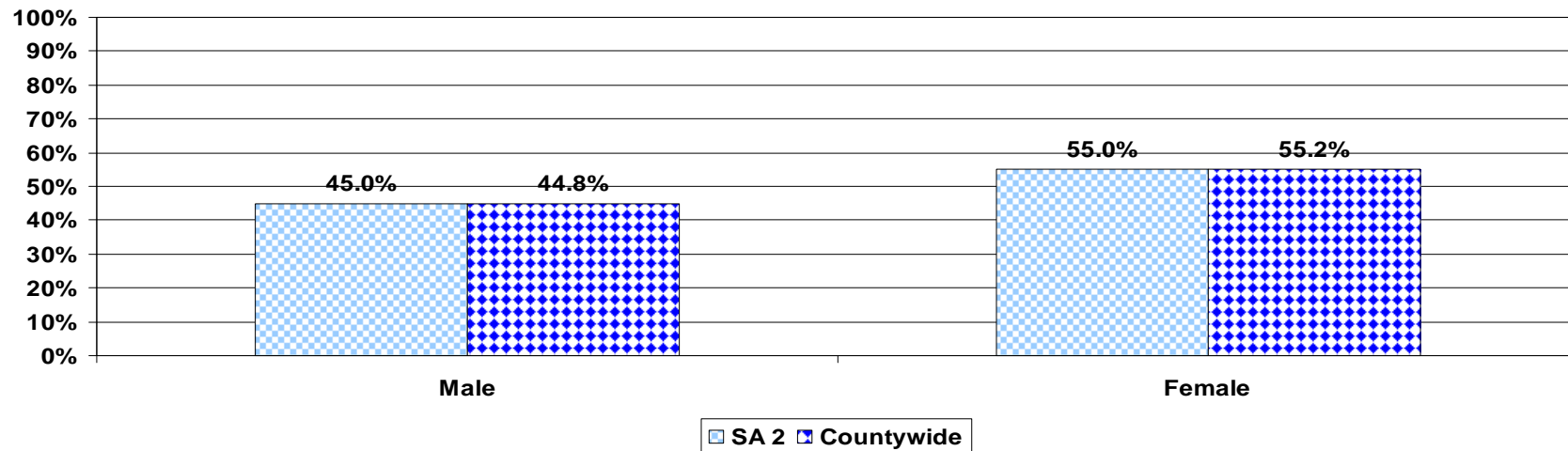
Figure 14: Medi-Cal Enrolled Population by Age Group in SA 2 Compared with Countywide March 2011

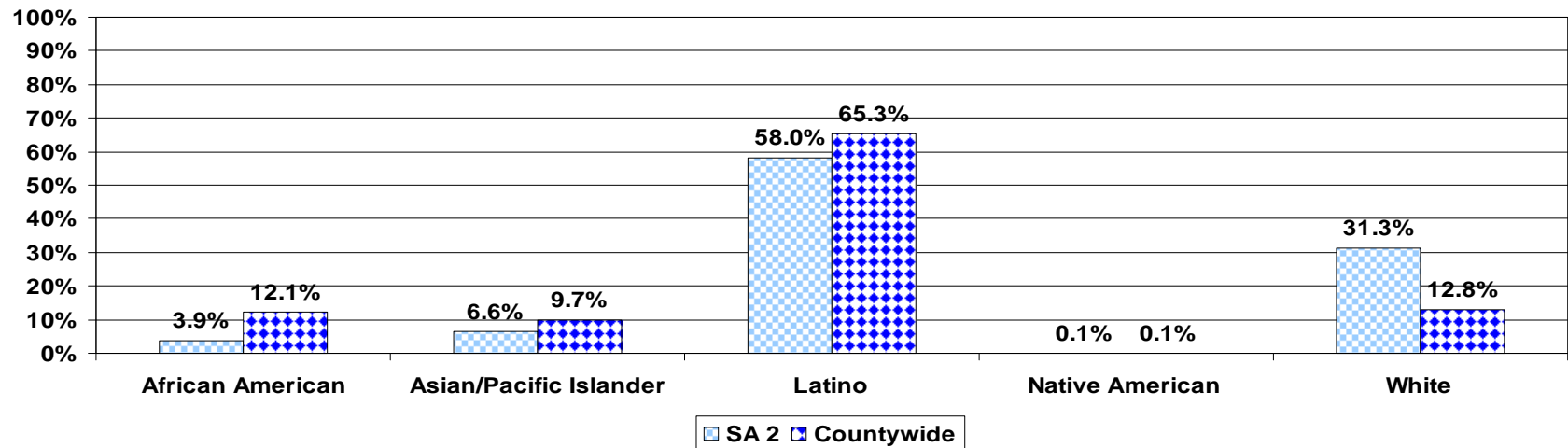
## Figure 15: Medi-Cal Enrolled Population by Gender in SA 2 Compared with Countywide March 2011

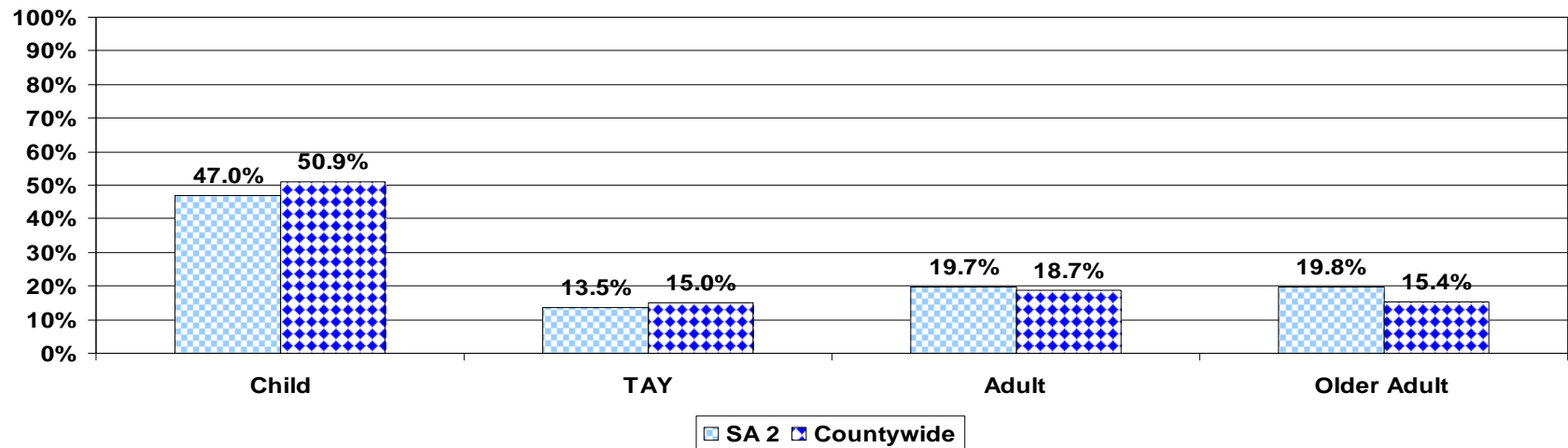
Figure 16: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI Among Medi-Cal Enrolled Population by Ethnicity in SA 2 Compared with Countywide March 2011

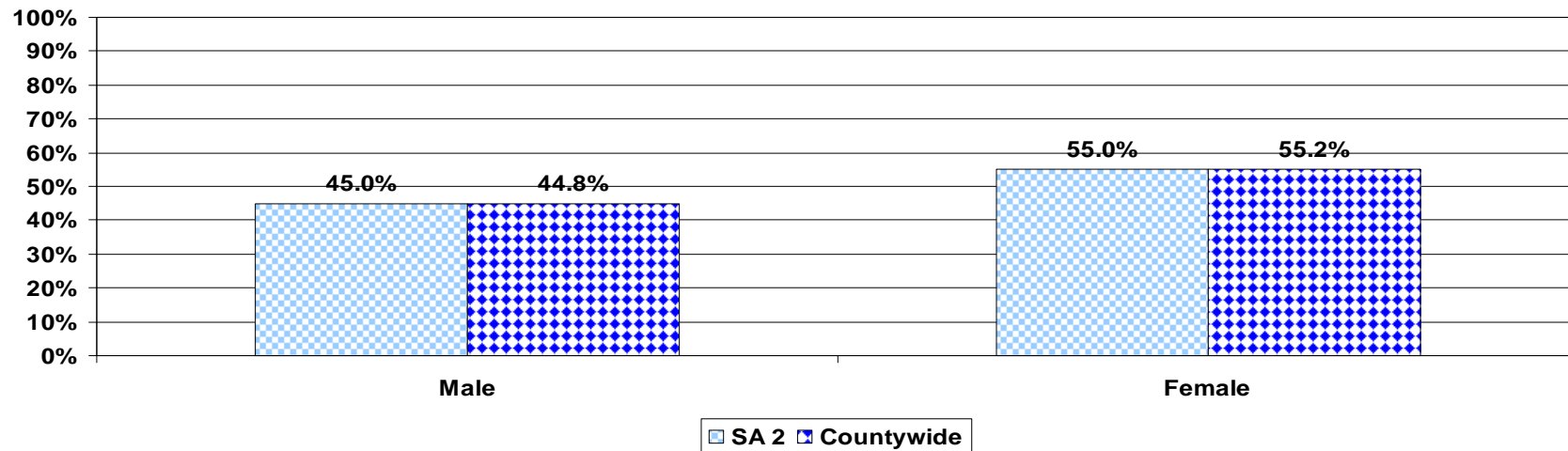
Figure 17: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI Among Medi-Cal Enrolled Population by Age Group in SA 2 Compared with Countywide March 2011

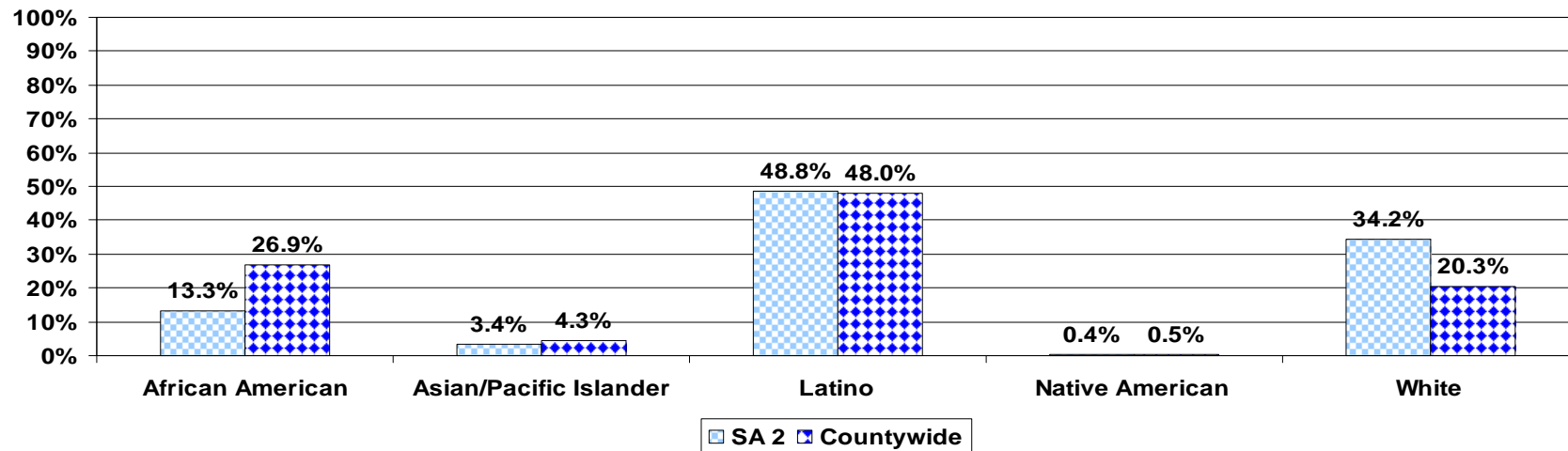
Figure 18: Estimated Prevalence of SED and SMI Among Medi-Cal Enrolled Population by Gender in SA 2 Compared with Countywide

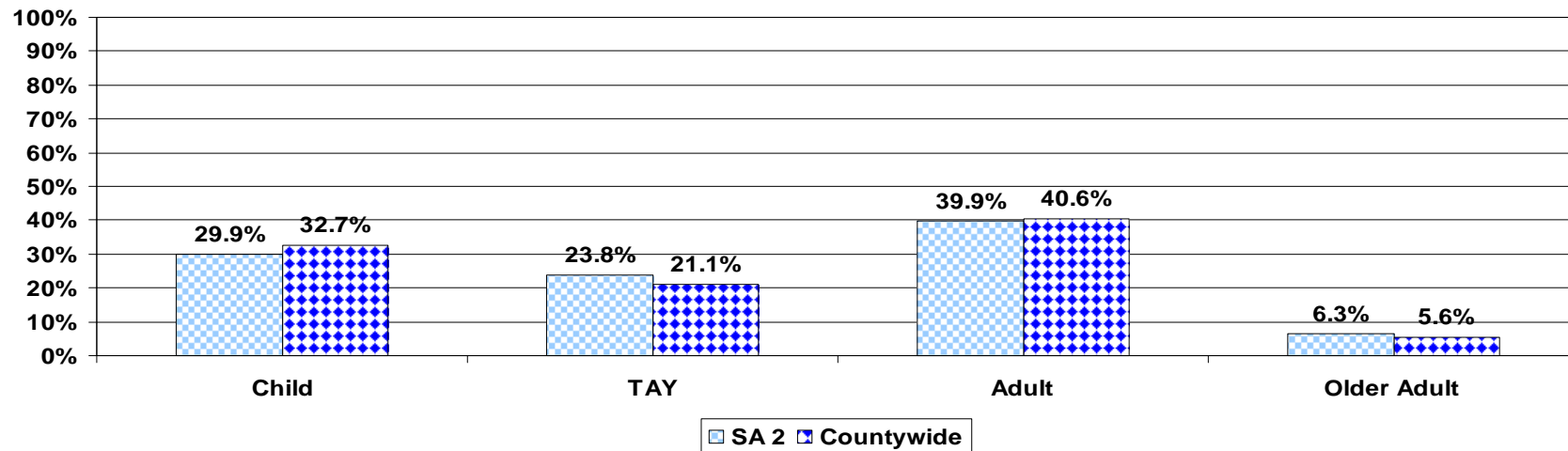
Figure 19: Consumers Served in Outpatient Short Doyle/Medi-Cal Facilities by Ethnicity in SA 2 Compared with Countywide FY 2010 - 2011

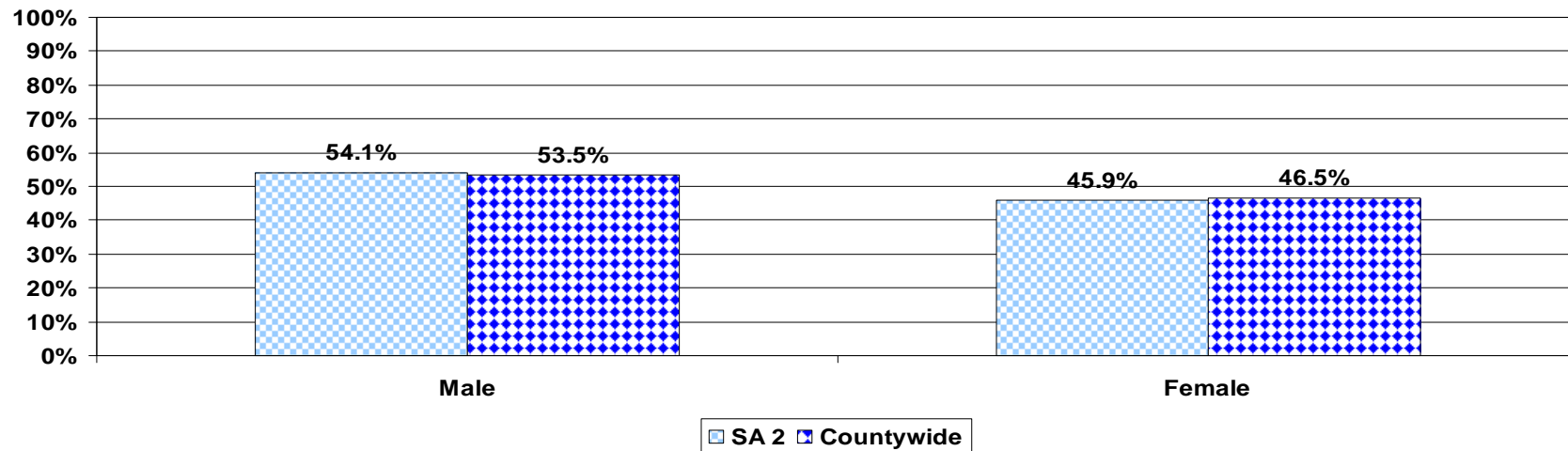
Figure 20: Consumers Served in Outpatient Short Doyle/Medi-Cal Facilities by Age Group in SA 2 Compared with Countywide FY 2010 - 2011

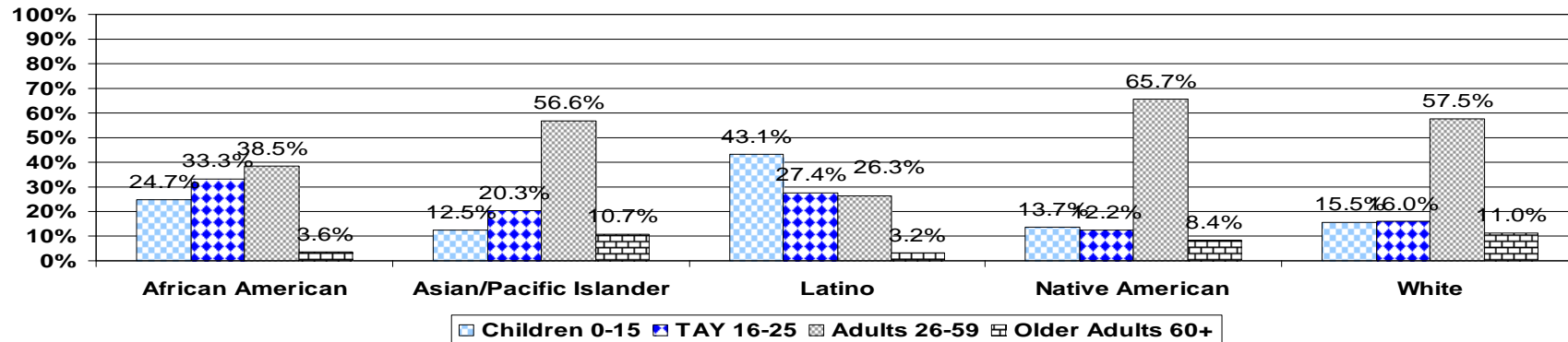

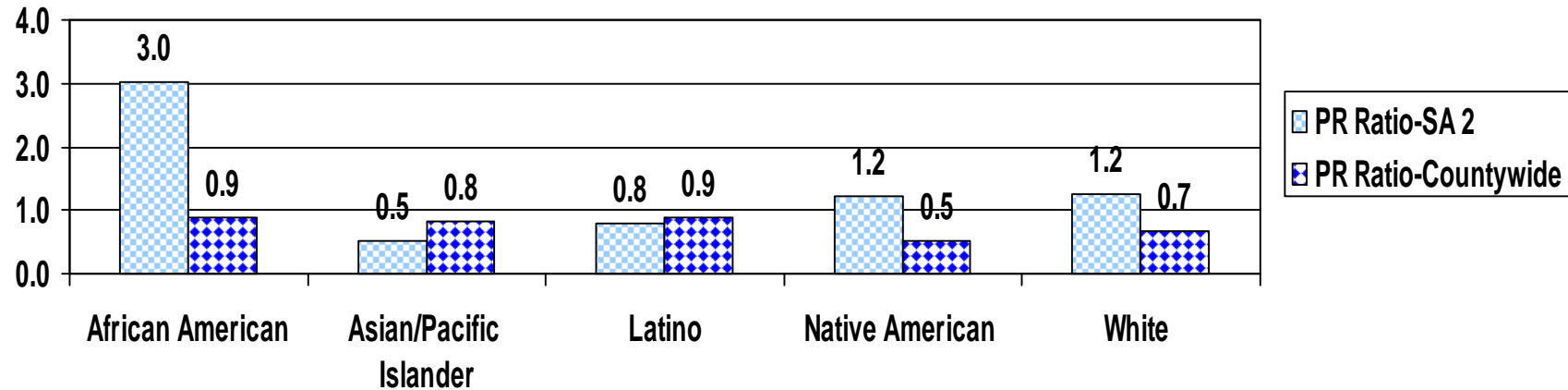
Figure 22: Consumers Served in SA 2 Outpatient Short Doyle/Medi-Cal Facilities by Ethnicity and Age Group

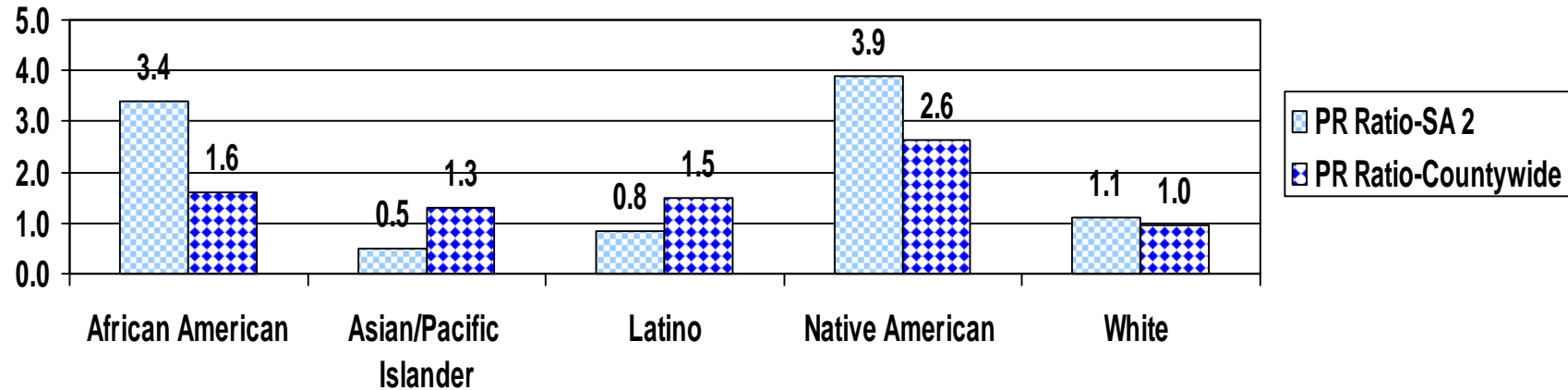
For example, a PRR of 3.0 ( $208.9/69.4 = 3.0$ , see Table 1) for African Americans in SA 2 indicates that African Americans are 3.0 times as likely to receive MHS in SA 2 as compared with all other ethnic group consumers in SA 2. A PRR of .90 ( $208.9/232.0 = .90$ ) for African Americans – Countywide indicates that African Americans are .90 times as likely to receive MHS in SA 2 as compared with all other African American consumers in the County of Los Angeles. Please note that PRR only take into account two factors and are not multivariate analysis.

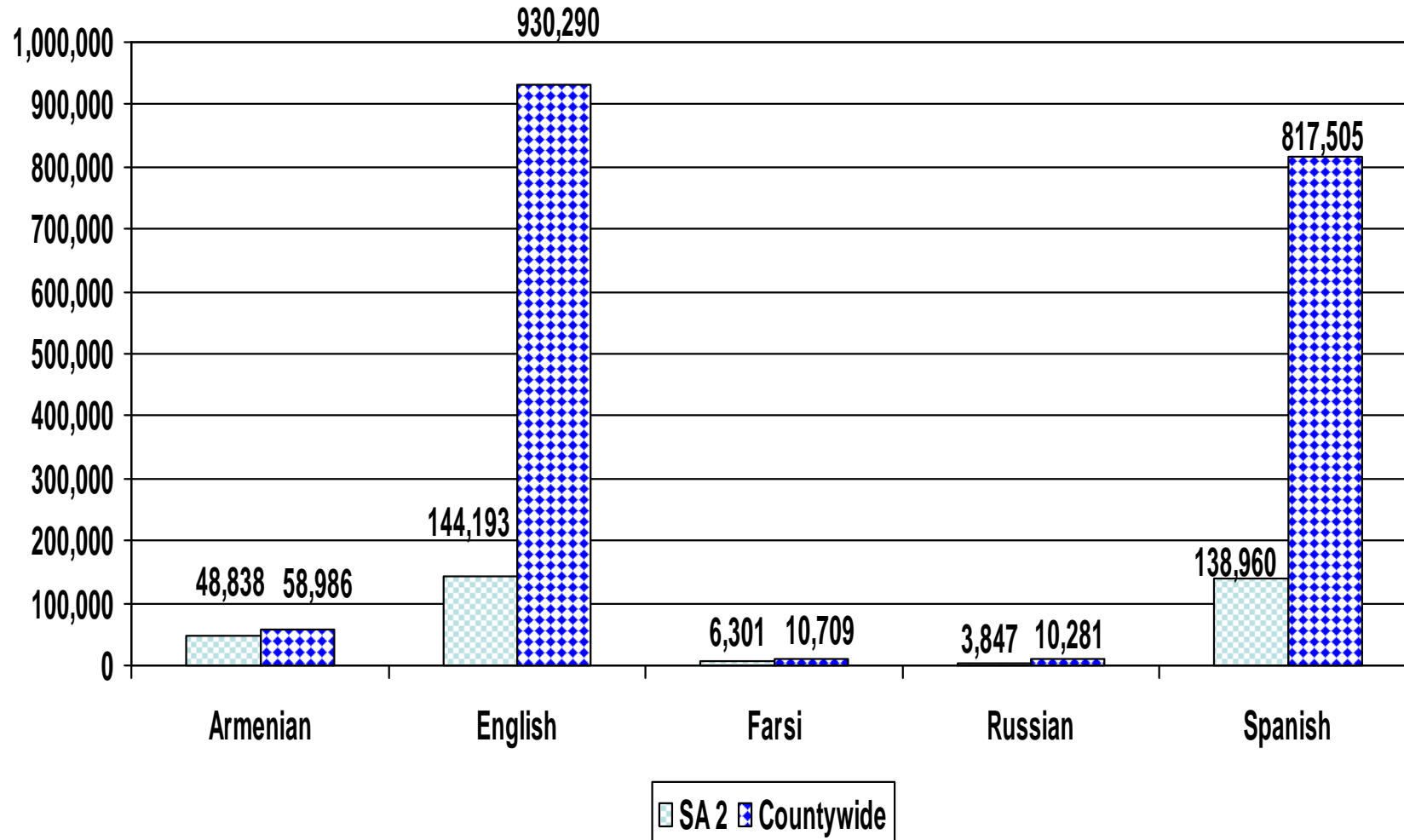

Countywide (CW) Penetration Rate Ratio is calculated as: PR for a group within SA divided by Total CW PR for that group. PRRs reflect the likelihood of group with MHS needs being served as compared with other groups being served within SA or Countywide. Please note that PRR only take into account two factors and are not multivariate analysis.

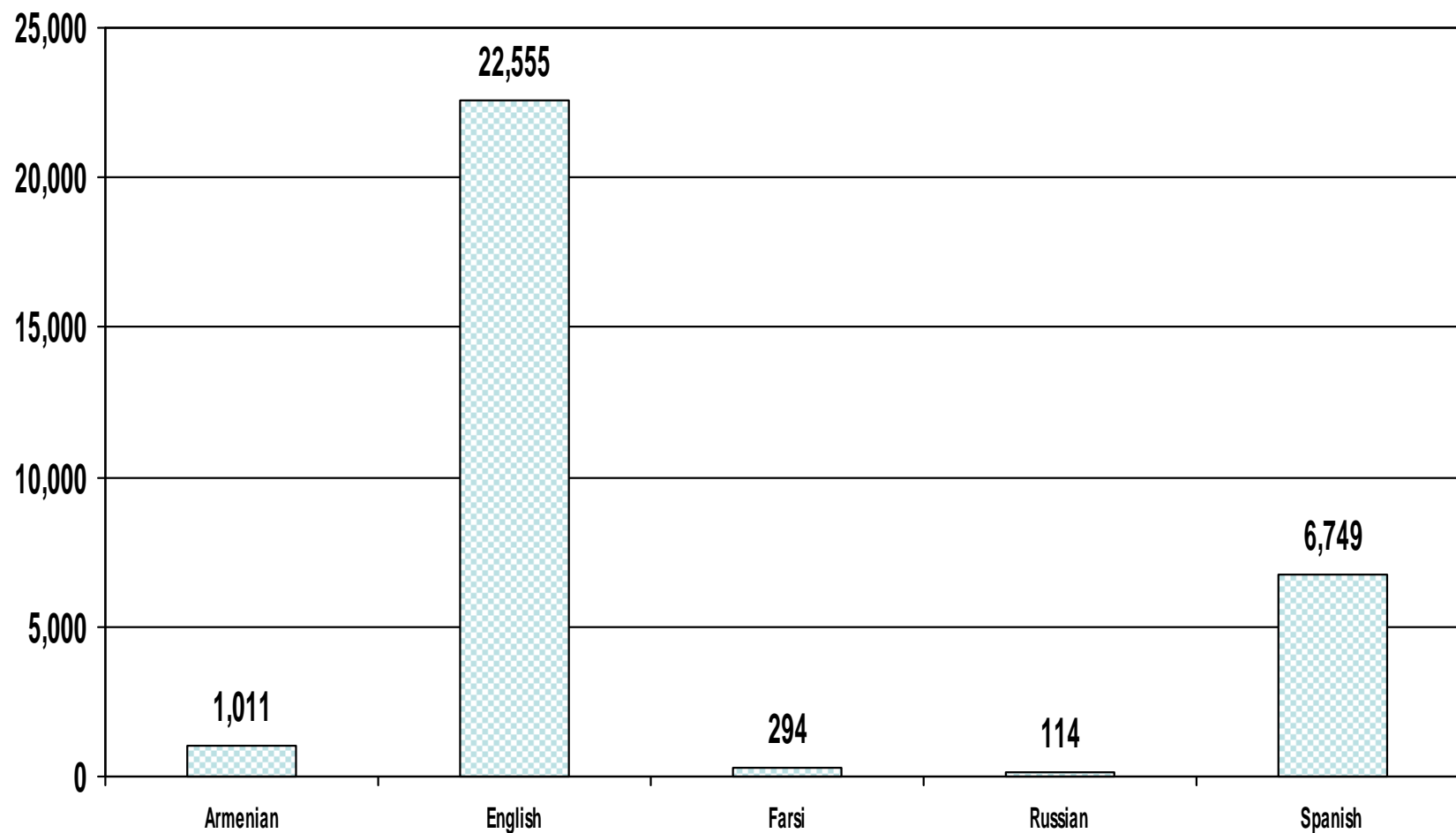
